# 第3課

# 筆記 ライティング(1)



- ・第3課では、複数の段落からなる英文を要約するタイプの問題について学習します。
- ・ さまざまなテーマで書かれた英文でも、全体を要約するには共通のテクニックがあるので、押さえま しょう。

### 要点整理

英文は3段落程度で示されており、その多くが以下の構成です。要約する問題の場合、各段落の内容をしっかりと読み取ることが大切ですが、この構成を理解しておくと段落ごとの大意を把握しやすくなります。

第1段落	身近なトピックや近年の社会現象、出来事などを引き合いに出して、英文全体のテーマを示す。
第2段落	第1段落で示されたテーマについて、1つの見解を述べる。
第3段落	第2段落の見解に対する批判や、まったく別の見解などを述べる。

Why has online shopping become so popular? The biggest reason is that people can buy what they want anytime, anywhere. Another reason is that people can have heavy items delivered to their home. Online shopping is so convenient that it is essential for busy people today.

On the other hand, there are also problems caused by online shopping. Some people are disappointed when what they receive is completely different from what they expected. There is also the risk that personal information such as addresses and credit card numbers may be leaked.

解説 各段落に書かれた内容を、それぞれ簡潔にまとめましょう。例題では、shopping「買い物」や buying things online「オンラインで物を買うこと」がトピックです。第1段落では、「近年オンラインで買い物をする人々が増えていること」が述べられています。第2段落では、冒頭で「なぜオンラインショッピングはとても人気になったのでしょうか」と疑問が提起され、その理由が「欲しい物をいつでもどこでも買うことができること」や「重たい物を家に配達してもらうことができること」といった利便性にあると述べられています。第3段落では、オンラインショッピングの問題点として「思っていたものと届いたものが違うこと」や「個人情報漏えいのリスクがあること」が挙げられています。

Nowadays, people prefer buying things online. Online shopping is convenient because people can buy things anytime, anywhere. People don't have to carry heavy items, either. However, it has some problems, too. For example, what people get sometimes turns out very different from what they expected. Also, there is concern over the leakage of personal information.

*Man*: Actually, no. Our city doesn't collect bottles or cans in this neighborhood, so I bring them to the supermarket.

**Woman:** Doesn't the city recycle in this area?

*Man*: Yeah, it's a lot of trouble carrying them to the supermarket. But our city announced that they would start collecting bottles and cans next year.

Question: What does the man do with his empty bottles and cans?

解説 例題の質問は What does the man do with his empty bottles and cans? 「男性は空の瓶や缶をどのように処理しますか」で、正しい内容の選択肢を選ぶ問題です。男性は「ぼくたちの市はこの近所では瓶や缶を回収しないから、ぼくはそれらをスーパーマーケットに持って行っているんだ」と言っているので、1 が正解です。supermarket「スーパーマーケット」などのキーワードを聞き逃さないようにしましょう。
