- 解説 (1) 「アーロン・グラントがブラックさんについて聞いたことは何ですか」という質問です。第1段落の 2 文目から、アーロンの母がブラックさんの E メールアドレスをアーロンに知らせる許可をブラックさん本人からもらったということがわかります。したがって、1「彼女はアーロンの母に、彼女の連絡先を共有することを許した」が最も適切です。2「彼女は他の人々に驚かされると不快に感じるかもしれない」、3「彼女は地元の地域で最も強いテニス選手だ」、4「彼女はテニスの個人レッスンを教えることに興味がある」。
 - (2) 「先月、アーロン・グラントに何が起こりましたか」という質問です。第2段落2、3文目から、アーロンは先月の試合で、勝てると思った選手に負けたということがわかります。よって、4「彼は勝てるかもしれなかった試合で負けた」が最も適切です。1「彼は高校でテニス部に加わった」、2「彼は楽しい娯楽としてテニスを楽しみ始めた」、3「彼は試合で彼に勝つことができたであろう相手を倒した」。
 - (3) 「アーロン・グラントはブラックさんに~ことをお願いしています」という文を完成させるものを選びます。第3段落の1文目で、アーロンはブラックさんに、1週間に一度だけでもいいからテニスを教えてほしいと述べていて、3文目では月に一度でもいいので教えてほしいと述べています。したがって、4「あまり頻繁ではなくても彼を指導する」が最も適切です。1「レッスン料について彼の母と連絡を取る」、2「週に一度テニスコートの予約を取る」、3「州大会で勝つためにテニスの仕方を彼に教える」。
